### 1. Disorientation (D):

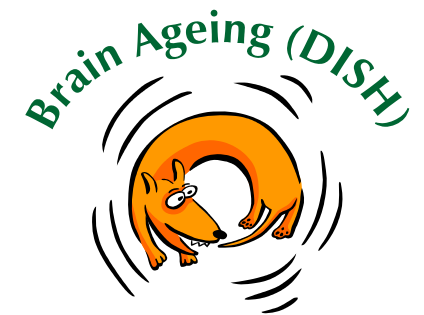
